Step 4 How to make a good intro? < Ask: What's the purpose of an intro? >

- 1) use a question. < Tell them don't answer it? >
ex: Are there any problems people have living in a new country?
- 2) use a short story or example < make it up - lie. No one will know. >
< stories are interesting and they take up space >

* Tom in Alaska ⊕ language problem

3) Use statistics/facts (make them up at ERLI, but not in the university)

80% of international students experience language issues in a new country

4) Use a Quote (make one up)

"Coming to the U.S. was one of the most difficult experiences of my life," reported Tom

Step #5 Add the intro to their body paragraphs

Step #6 [How to write a conclusion]

- re-state the thesis statement in another way
- offer advice or a suggestion
 - a way to solve a problem
 - further research
 - something specific to the topic
- In the intro they told a story, so come back to it

Step #7 Add conclusion to their essay

Step #8 Add transitions into the essay
